La Muse

Profound and sophisticated, La Muse delivers the incredible depth and texture of Merlot from the top micro-crus of eastern Sonoma County. Like a graceful swan, it embodies elegance, softness, and strength.

Crafted from Bordeaux varieties, this is a wine of supple fruit and earthen spice, with a seamless melding of finesse and power. Its exceptional balance and length highlight Merlot's potential in the New World.



La Joie

Derived from a layered concentration of Cabernet Sauvignon grown along the steep hillsides and volcanic benches of the Mayacamas Mountains, La Joie is a commanding Bordeaux blend that will reward the patient collector. A true thoroughbred, it is exuberant, energetic, and proud—eager to show off at the first opportunity.



Le Désir

Bound by precision, elegance, and grace, Le Désir is a Cabernet Franc-based blend that exudes high-toned aromatics, an iron graphite core, and pronounced minerality. The opulent bouquet is echoed by layers of concentrated fruit and exotic spice, and complemented with a plush sueded texture. It is a complex symphony, presenting at first a quiet force that will unveil its many delicate and mysterious layers over time.



The Palette of Vérité

A mosaic of more than 50 micro-crus provides Vigneron Pierre Seillan with the complex palette of aromatics, flavors, textures, and structural elements that he needs to craft the wines of Vérité.

Each micro-cru is harvested and fermented separately, then aged in French oak barrels of various custom toasts. Seillan carefully tailors his winemaking techniques and oak regimens to the personality of each lot. This provides him with hundreds of unique components he can use to create the architecture of the final blends of La Muse, La Joie, and Le Désir.



Sonoma County

Sonoma County is one of the most diverse grapegrowing regions on earth. Due to the influence of the Pacific Ocean, the climate flows from west to east, rather than north to south. The eastern inland appellations are warm, dry, and ideal for Bordeaux varieties such as Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc. The microclimates in each appellation are warm enough to fully ripen red Bordeaux varieties, but cool enough to retain the natural acidity needed to make timeless, age-worthy wines.





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
